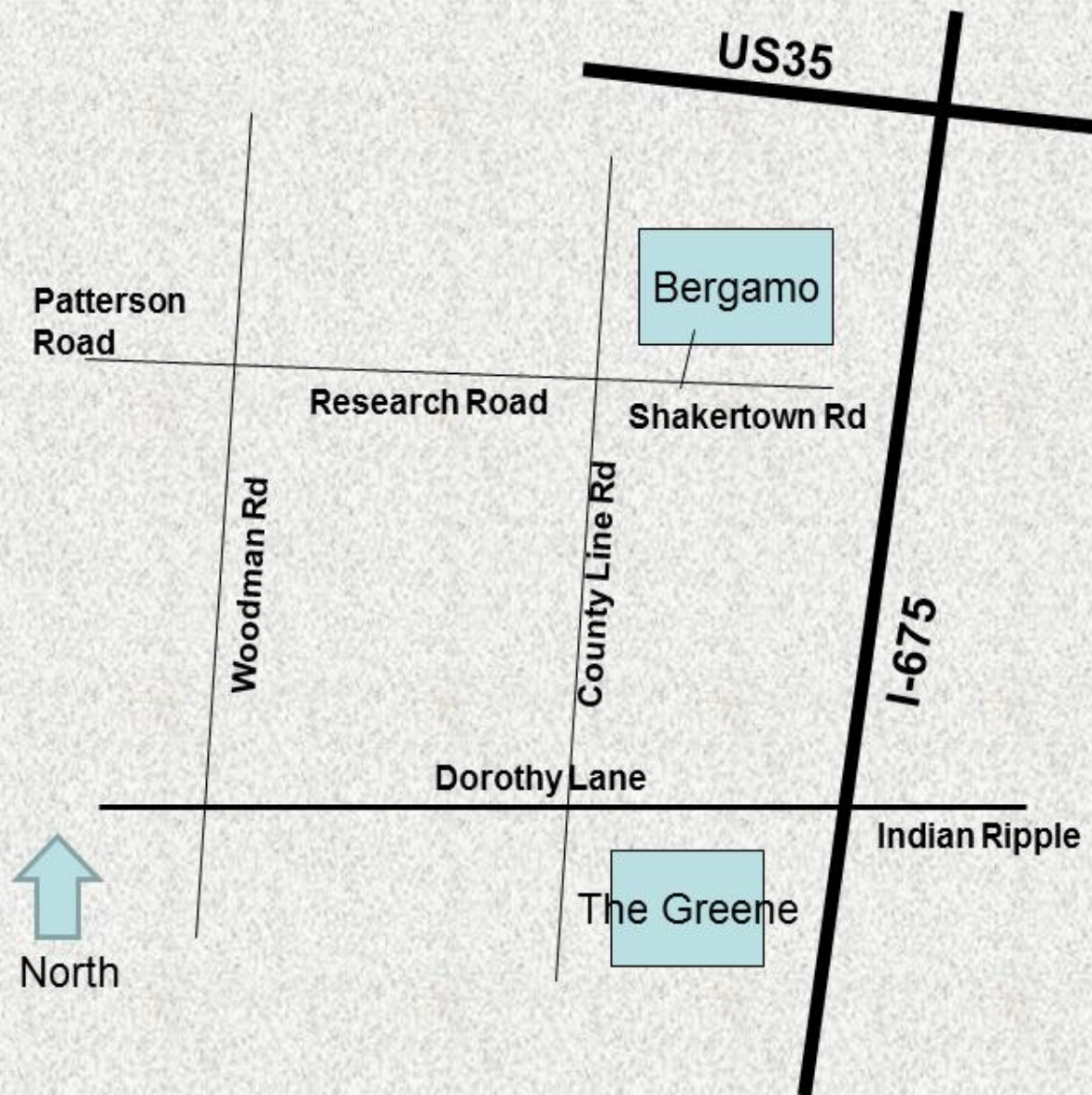

Directions: However you can, get to the intersection of Research (Research becomes Shakertown) and County Line roads. Go 2 tenths mile east (Continue on Shakertown) and turn north into driveway by sign that says Bergamo/Mt St John. In other-words, go to Bergamo.
